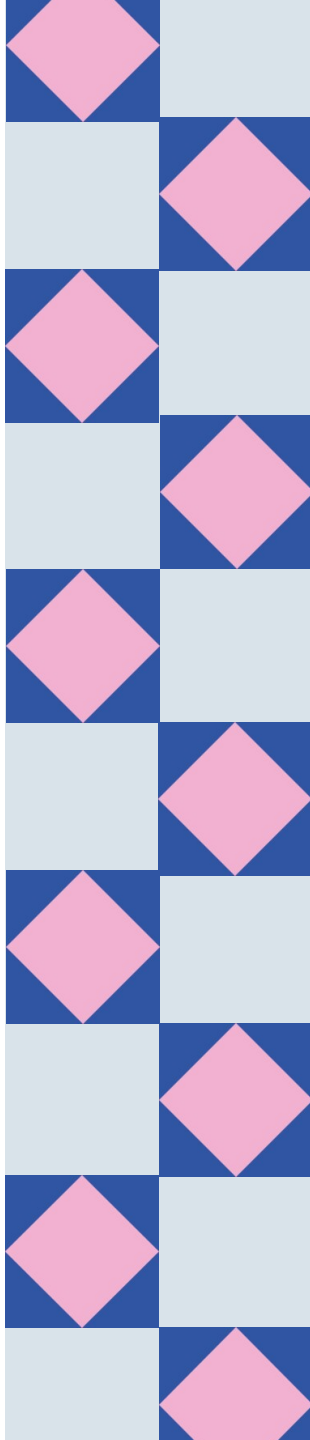
Floss flew down to hear what they were saying.

One after the other, the people sit down with dripping wet faces. They look out the window to see another clown driving a tram.

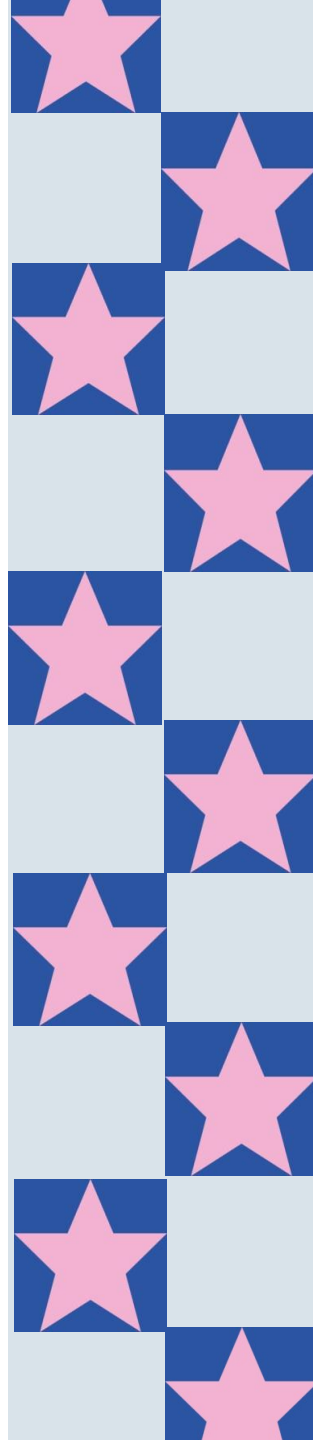
“Ready, steady, go!!”.

The people give it a try. They all bump into each other and stand on each other’s toes.

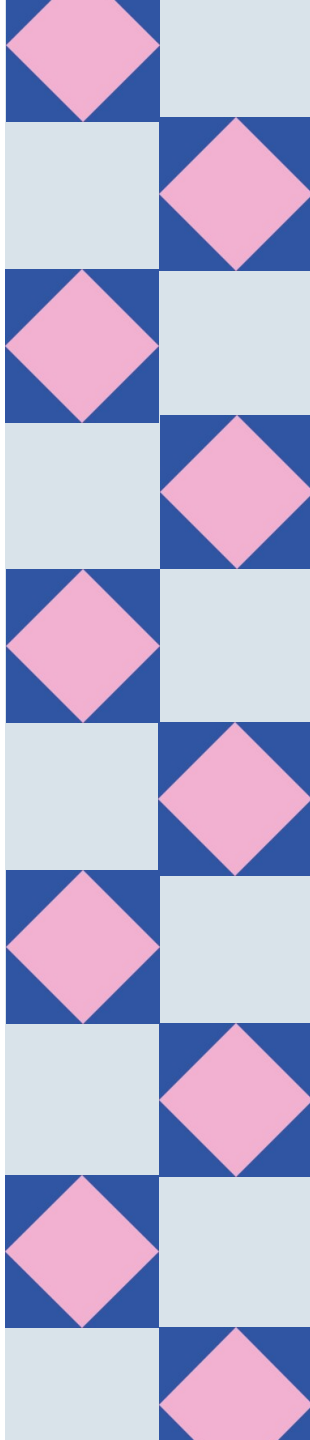
“Wonderful everyone, I think we are ready for the music!” says one Taxi driver.

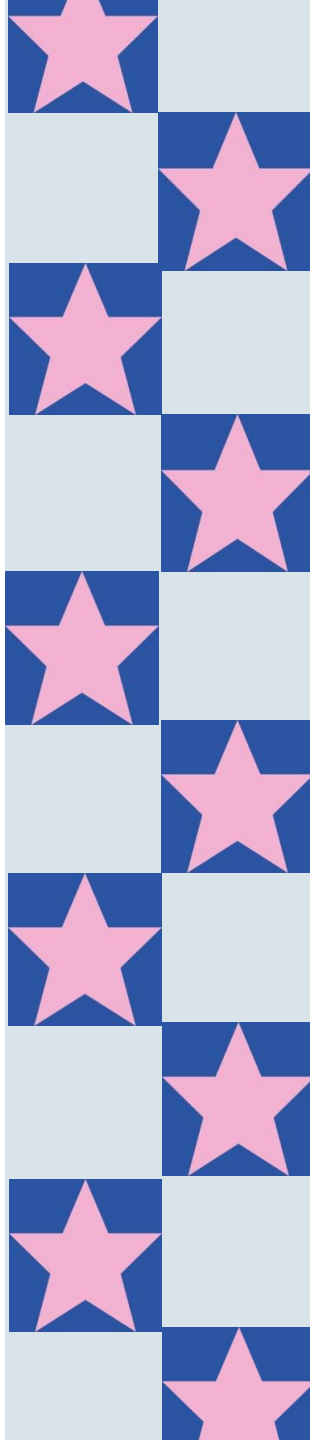

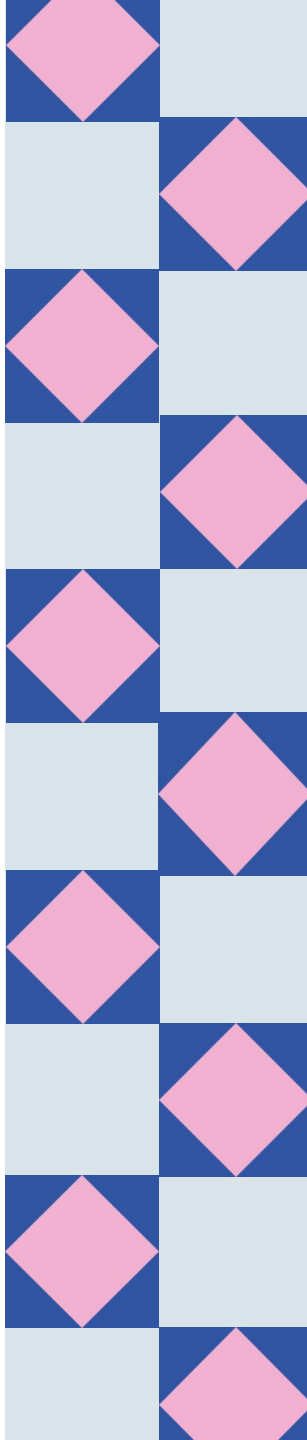
